We wish to make it clear that our single objective is to ensure that those who served at Royal Air Force Kirmington and those who lost their lives flying from that RAF station are properly and respectfully remembered, now and by future generations.

We will assist in any way we can to expediate the installation of a suitable Memorial, if this assistance is requested, and look forward to the Memorial garden once again becomes a fitting memorial to all that served with 166 Sqn at RAF Kirmington and honours those who lost their lives.

We wish to make it clear that we did not authorise the removal of the original memorial stone and the Parish Council had already cancelled their Contractor who was going to carry out the work on the Memorial Stone. The Parish Council have, as yet not received an explanation why the removal took place.
