- Cllr Marsden advised that the highlight of the year is the work to date on the playing field, in particular the excellent work that Cllr Walton has done. It is looking tidy again and has made a big impact and is now being used again by the villagers. All Councillors present expressed a vote of thanks to Cllr Walton.  
In the long term the Parish Council is looking at further development, grants and the long term use of the playing field. The lease has been renewed for 15 years. Cllr Wells has done a good job with his monthly health and safety inspections. Overall it has been a very good year for the site.
- The work done with regards to noise monitoring at Humberside Airport. After 13 years with no noise monitoring carried out, this has begun again after the Airport have purchased new equipment. There is one fixed monitor and one portable monitor. Data is now available monthly on the Airport website.
- The Parish Council are now involved with other groups such as NATS, they have 2 representatives, Cllr Marsden has attended the last 3 Parish & Town Liaison meetings, The Airport Consultative Committee and Singleton Birch. The Parish Council have spread their wings attending other meetings.
- The membership of the Council has been 2 short in the last year and there is a possible pending election, residents have expressed their interest in joining. It is good that people are showing an interest in the Parish Council by wanting to be involved.
- C137 is an ongoing problem. There has been a cycle race recently

and during the race 2 HGV's tried to pass one another on the road. The Parish Council need to keep up the pressure to the Authorities regarding the conditions on this road. This will be raised at the meeting due to be held with Martin Vickers, MP.

- 166 Squadron is now an Annual Memorial Service, held on the first Saturday in September. This is well attended and is good for the village that this is held annually.
