The playing field progress has progressed well during the last 12 months. Cllr Walton 's work has been fantastic to date and has been recognised by both residents and visitors, who are looking forward to the development. Long may it continue. The Crew of HMS Brocklesby commented on how well the playing field looked on their recent visit. Funding will be applied for this financial year for the development.

The 166 Squadron Reunion Annual Remembrance Service will continue as long as the 866 sqn ATC Immingham organise the event. It is held the first Saturday in September and it is to remember Members of the Squadron who served RAF Kirmington. Let's hope it may continue for many years to come.

A Remembrance Service was held on the first time in many years on 11.11.11 at the War Memorial at the Church, it was a great success. It was supported by the school. This event should now continue as an annual event.

There has been a breakthrough on the C137 issues. The weight restriction on the C137 which the Parish Council have been campaigning for the last 12 years has been agreed. A date for this to be implemented is still being awaited. However, this is a credit to the Parish Council for keeping the pressure on to get the weight restriction put on the very minor 'C' road.

The Parish Council has achieved success in working alongside the Airport, in obtaining Noise Monitoring Reports from the website. The noise levels are at reasonable levels now.

There is disappointment that the Olympic Torch will not be passing through the Parishes. It is poor planning by the organisers and the Parish Council should have been consulted regarding the route, which will now go down the A180 to Immingham and not along the A18 as requested and will not be seen by many people.

Cllr Page has organised the projects in the village of Kirmington in keeping the village tidy. He is doing an excellent job liaising with residents.

The Parish Council now has a full strength of members at the maximum of 8 Councillors.

The Parish Council Website will become live this year.

The Jubilee Street Party will be held in June.
