

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday, 4th June, 2013, at 7.30pm, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

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01.06.13- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Whincop, Cllr Clark

02.06.13 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest in any Airport or Aviation issues, as he works in the Aviation Industry. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 06.06.13, as he works in the Airport Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.06.13, regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the Agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

03.06.13- To confirm the minutes of the AGM held on 8th May, 2013

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Hannigan and seconded by Cllr Gallimore.

04.06.13 - Public Participation

None

05.06.13 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items are covered on the agenda.

06.06.13 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

There have been no further Airport Consultative Committee meetings held.

The Humberside Airport website is currently up to date, with latest available noise monitoring figures on until April 2013. Apart from one noisy day on 17th April, all other data is acceptable.

The Airport have informed they are looking at relocating the portable noise monitor at the suggested location by the Parish Council and are at present trying to locate a power source.

07.06.13 - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

The next NATS meeting is to be held on 07.06.13 at Goxhill. Cllr Hannigan will try to attend.

No further updates on wildlife crime.

08.06.13 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Wells advised that there may be more funding available for Youth Services and he will keep the Parish Council informed of any further developments.

09.06.13 - To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

The results from the Lincolnshire County Council traffic study at Grasby Bottom have similar figures to North Lincolnshire Council.

Cllr Page informed that not all of the potholes at Eastend Lane/Post Office Lane have been repaired. Cllr Wells will chase this up.

The gully on the A18 - southside of the Airport crossroads needs cleaning. Clerk to report and to request a map of gully numbers for future reference.

10.06.13 - To receive planning decisions made by North Lincolnshire Council and consider any planning applications received where comments have to be submitted before the next meeting

None received, but all agreed once the revised plans are received from Singleton Birch Clerk to send in the comments as discussed on 11.06.13.

11.06.13 - Any Updates on Singleton Birch AD Plant - Presentation by Martin Haworth regarding new proposals

Martin informed that Singleton-Birch have now amended the plans to build a lagoon after taking into account the Parish Councils initial concerns regarding odours. He informed that amended plans have been submitted to North Lincolnshire Council. The entrance to the site will be the existing one at present, but in the future they hope to relocate the

entrance.

All Councilors' present agreed that the Clerk to email Planning at North Lincolnshire Council to inform that the Parish Council are strongly in favour of the new proposal and have no objections.

Cllr Gallimore asked if Singleton-Birch would consider purchasing speed reduction signs in Croxton. Martin advised the Clerk to obtain prices and to send the request to him. Cllr Wells will provide the Clerk with current pricelist.

Cllr Page conveyed the Parish Council thanks for the landfill grant for the playing field.

12.06.13 - Any Updates on Pimlico Farm

It appears that work has commenced, but the Parish Council has not been officially advised.

13.06.13 - (a) - To discuss progress on the Playing Field and work to date

Cllr Walton informed that due to personal circumstances he has fallen behind with grass cutting at present. There are no football matches in the foreseeable future.

Cllr Marsden told Cllr Walton if he needs any assistance to let him know and all Councilors' available will give him a hand if required.

(b) - To consider the proposal of a pavilion on the Playing Field

Clerk advised that at present the Bowls Club future is uncertain and it may be possible to use their facilities on a more regular basis. Also advised that any grant funding the Parish Council would need a 10% deposit and need to show that they could afford the upkeep and running costs. All Councilors' present advised to keep on the agenda for further updates and consideration in the future.

14.06.13 - To discuss any further ideas for the layout of the Parish Council Website

The Website is working well.

Cllr Page will supply the Clerk with photos of the play park open day to be displayed on the website.

15.06.13 - To discuss ideas for Remembrance Day 2013

Clerk read out email from Rev'd Mary Vickers who is of the opinion that the event should be similar to the 2011 event with no Church Service due to the day being a Monday. It was agreed to wait for a response from Nicky Angelier for her opinion and to consider whether a Church service

is viable. Cllr Hannigan will speak to Nicky Angelier.

No response from Simon Dunn regarding a Bugler. Clerk to chase up.

16.06.13 - Any updates regarding Broadband Speeds in the Parishes

The BT upgrade at Melton Ross exchange is scheduled for September.

The speeds are very slow at present.

It was agreed that the Clerk write to North Lincolnshire Council to ask when Melton Ross - Kirmington will be upgraded and can they advise where the fibre is going and how the £2.6 million funding is being allocated.

17.06.13 - Correspondence

Clerk advised the notice board at Ransome Court needs replacing and she has received a quote for £240 to replace the board and to keep the existing posts. It was agreed that the Clerk to obtain 2 further quotations for comparison. Cllr Page will get one and Clerk will obtain 1 other.

18.06.13 - Accounts

The May accounts were confirmed as a true and accurate record.

Proposed by Cllr Bridges and seconded by Cllr Gallimore.

19.06.13 - Minor Items

Cllr Hannigan has been approached by a resident asking if a brown sign can be provided advising of 'squadron memorial' within Kirmington. Clerk to obtain a quote for 2 signs.

Cllr Page asked if quotations could be obtained for 2 nice wooden village signs, similar to Habrough. Local landmarks such as the Squadron Memorial could be displayed on it. This was proposed by Cllr Page and seconded by Cllr Bridges. Clerk to obtain quotations.

Cllr Wells advised that North Lincolnshire Council may be able to provide new white signs with the coat of arms on. Clerk to obtain quotations.

Cllr Walton asked if the street name signs within the village could be cleaned.
