

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 9th June, 2015, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

Present - Cllr Page, Cllr Hannigan, Cllr Walton, Cllr Bridges, Cllr Gallimore, Cllr Wells, Cllr Marsden, Cllr Peter Clark, and Cllr Richard Hannigan.

01.06.15- To note Apologies for Absence

None

02.06.15 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest in any Airport or Aviation issues, as he works in the Aviation Industry; he also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 08.06.15, as he works in the Airport Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 11.06.15, regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road. Cllr Hannigan declared a personal interest in item 09.06.15 as she is a Police Volunteer.

Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

03.06.15- To confirm the minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 19th May 2015

05.06.15 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

06.06.15 - To consider casual vacancy applications received for co-option

The Parish Council considered the applications received and all present agreed to co-opt Miguel D'Souza. Proposed by Cllr Gallimore and seconded by Cllr Bridges.

07.06.15 - Appointment to be made for Police/NATS representative
Cllr Wells is the Vice Chairperson of this group and has agreed to represent Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council also.

08.06.15 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

The Commercial Director, Paul Litten has left the Airport and his post will not be filled.

The Travel Shop recently celebrated its 10th birthday.

The Airport roundabout is scheduled to be finished July 2015.

Noise monitoring figures are within guidelines, although there have been complaints of the helicopters flying over the village during the night on their return visits. Cllr Marsden has discussed this with Chief Pilot Liz Forsyth who agreed to send a memo to her crews to remind them not to do this. Liz will try to attend the July Parish Council meeting.

The Residents Pass form has gone onto the Parish Council Website for residents to complete if required and return to the Airport with ID to obtain their pass.

10.06.15 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

The new cabinet has recently been elected.

11.06.15 - (a)To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Figures received from the Croxton Speed Signs show there is a regular offender who speeds at 82mph in the village.

It was resolved - Clerk to request to Roy Hindmarsh for Police to target this location at the times of this regular offender

Clerk advised the bin the Airport lay by should be replaced imminently.

Cllr Wells asked Clerk to write to Cllr Neil Poole to ask where Kirmington School Safety Scheme is on the list.

(b) - Any updates on Melton Ross Bridge repairs

Cllr Richard Hannigan advised the realistic date for the bridge repairs is likely to be 3-4 years. He has been informed that the bridge should be propped up by October 2015; when the traffic will then be 2 way once again and fully open to LGV's & HGV's.

Cllr Page expressed concern over the footpath from Croxton to Kirmington. Clerk advised Wayne Hill had contacted her to inform that they cannot repair this until the Melton Ross Bridge is repaired and Lorries no longer use the diversion route.

It was resolved - Clerk to write to Wayne Hill & Steve Harrison expressing the Parish Council concerns that pushchairs, mobility scooters and school children are not able to use this path at present and to ask for this to be repaired sooner and for it to be scraped off now so users can use during the summer period. Also to request the Golden Rivers on the C137 East End Lane.
