

## KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting of Kirmington & Croxton Parish Council, held on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2015, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

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### 01.07.15- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Anne Hannigan, Cllr J Bridges & Cllr T Walton

### 02.07.15 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest in any Airport or Aviation issues, as he works in the Aviation Industry; he also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 06.07.15, as he works in the Airport Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.07.15, regarding highway issues on the C137, as he owns a property accessed by this road. Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

### 03.07.15- To confirm the minutes of the Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2015

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Page and seconded by Cllr Wells.

### 04.07.15 - Public Participation

### 05.07.15 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items are covered on the agenda.

### 06.07.15 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

Cllr Marsden is now receiving the noise monitoring figures from the airport prior to them going on their website. At present they are within the government guidelines.

Captain Liz Forsyth was unable to attend the recent Parish Council

meetings due to her working commitments, but she has invited Members of the Parish Council to have a tour of the new facility. All Members present agreed for Cllr Marsden to arrange this at a later date.

(b) - To discuss the noise complaint

Chris Wild from Humberside Airport copied the Parish Council in on a complaint received from a local resident. No contact has been made to the Parish Council by the resident.

It was noted that at least a couple of residents have reported noise complaints direct to the Airport recently and had no response.

07.07.15 (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

No further meeting has been held.

No local wildlife crime has been reported.

Cllr Gallimore asked Cllr Wells to raise at the next meeting the issue of the Melton Ross Bridge not being policed.

08.07.15 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Richard Hannigan reported potholes from Kirmington - Croxton have been repaired.

Community Wardens have been appointed and will be providing their contact details shortly.

The Parish Council will be receiving a grass cutting map of areas that North Lincolnshire Council are responsible for.

09.07.15 - (a) To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Cllr Marsden reported the A18 is chaos at present, with 3 sets of traffic lights at short distances apart.

(b) - Any updates on Melton Ross Bridge repairs

Cllr Richard Hannigan agreed to look into the possibility of a camera been installed at this location by North Lincolnshire Council.

October 2015 is the bridge temporary completion date.

(c) - To consider the draft plans of the widening of Caistor Road

Cllr Marsden feels this project is a waste of money, as the Airport has no land at this side of the airport that could be developed.. He asked other Members opinions. All others present felt that as this had been approved to allow this to continue. Cllr Marsden and Cllr D'Souza will re-check the plans to ensure the drainage is suitable.

(d) - To discuss the response to the Kirmington School Safety Scheme  
All members present agreed for Clerk to write a letter to Neil Poole to request this item to be included in next year's budget for April 2016.

10.07.15 - To receive planning decisions made by North Lincolnshire Council and consider any planning applications received where comments have to be submitted before the next meeting

15.07.15 - Any updates regarding Broadband Speeds in the Parishes

Cllr Wells to order 2 wreaths and 14 crosses.

17.07.15 - Update on return visit for Twinning  
Cllr Richard Hannigan advised there will be approximately 10 Dutch Visitors on 4/5/6 September. The Ashbourne Hotel will provide accommodation at a discounted rate. A full programme of events is being arranged for their 3 day visit.

(b) - To consider quotations obtained for additional flag pole  
Clerk advised of quotes obtained.  
All present agreed to quote from Newton & Newton at a cost of £355 plus £50 carriage. Cllr D'Souza agreed to arrange delivery and installation at a lesser cost than quote obtained. Proposed by Cllr Wells and seconded by Cllr Gallimore.

18.07.15 - Correspondence  
Clerk advised of precept being written incorrect on audit and asked if wished to pay £30 plus VAT to amend this. All agreed as long as Clerk is ok with this to leave and wait for Auditors report.
