

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 13th September, 2016, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

01.09.16- To note Apologies for Absence

02.09.16 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared a personal interest in any Airport or Aviation issues, as he works in the Aviation industry; he also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work. Cllr Marsden declared an interest in item 06.09.16, as he works in the Aviation Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee. Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.09.16 regarding highway issues on the 137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared an interest in any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

03.09.16- To confirm the minutes of the meetings held on 5th July 2016

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Gallimore and seconded by Cllr Wells.

05.09.16 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

Cllr Marsden gave a summary since the summer recess.

Best Kept Village Competition - Very good results and remarks. Well done to everybody in keeping the village tidy. **It was resolved** - Clerk to write to the Brocklesby Estate to thank them for their work involved.

Grimsby Chums Walk - Cllr Marsden and Cllr Bridges both attended Limber

Church. Cllr Marsden read the names of the WW1 fallen from Kirmington & Croxton out at Limber and again at Brocklesby and then visited the Lancaster crash site in Brocklesby Woods as part of the walk.

Cllr Marsden will speak to Kit Read regarding the adoption of the Lancaster crash site in the wood.

Kirmington Gala - There was an excellent turn out this year, there was a fly past by the Coastguard S92, the Airport Fire & Rescue attended with a Fire vehicle, the local PCSO with a Police car, Brocklesby Hounds and Vintage cars & tractors; and there were games for the children. Thanks were conveyed to Cllr Mick Green and Cllr Hannigan for their hard work.

166 Memorial Service - The events had to be held inside the Church due to the weather. However, many attended and the day was enjoyed by all. AVM Paul Robinson, The New Dutch Air Attaché - Lt. Col Rob Arts, Martin Vickers MP, Peter & Carol Clark (Deputy Mayor & Mayoress of North Lincolnshire Council) all attended. **It was resolved** - Clerk to write letter of thanks to all the above who attended and also to invite to next year's event.

Cllr Hannigan attended meeting at 19.22 hours

06.09.16 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

Cllr Marsden attended the recent meeting in July. He advised the Airport Hotel is due to open in October 2016. The Police helicopter is now located at Wakefield, as part of National Police Air Support. 3 Bristow helicopters have moved to Norwich; so may be a little quieter.

He advised he has requested a copy of the risk assessment from the downwash of the Search and Rescue S92 helicopter crossing the C137.

The next meeting is scheduled for 30th November.

The latest Noise Monitoring figures are all within Government guidelines.

07.09.16 (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

The Community Police Officer has made contact with the Chairperson and the Clerk. 2 Officers were sent to the 166 event due to the VIPs attending. The Parish Council were not aware of any further incidents in the village,

although Cllr Page advised the Church has experienced vandalism recently to the water tap. Cllr Marsden advised the Church that they need to report the incidents. Cllr Marsden would attend the NATS meeting on 15th September as Cllr Wells was not available to attend.

08.09.16 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Marsden advised of a fatal accident at Fonerby Top. He has contacted Cllr Tony Turner at Lincolnshire Council to ask for a mirror on the junction. Cllr Marsden has received the latest traffic figures on the C137. They indicate high volumes of traffic. North Lincolnshire Council will limit this road to 50mph following pressure from the Parish Council.

'Low Flying Helicopters' signage to be erected following pressure from the Parish Council.

Cllr Gallimore expressed concerns over the speed limit on the B1211, as this keeps changing and is confusing for motorists.

Cllr Gallimore asked whether the road that goes past Croxton Church still needs to be weight restricted. The general feeling was yes. Cllr Wells advised tractors needing access can still use this if necessary.

Cllr Gallimore advised the Croxton clean-up has been completed.

Cllr Hannigan advised the no parking zone at the school has been refreshed temporarily until the new safety zone is installed.

Cllr Page advised he is pleased with the new Barnetby Top Roundabout.

Cllr Page expressed concerns over the state of footpaths and potholes in the village of Kirmington. Cllr Wells advised NLC are pricing this up at present.
