

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Parish Council meeting, held on Tuesday 6th December, 2016, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

01.12.16- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Walton, Cllr Peter Clark

02.12.16 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Wells declared an interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

Cllr Wells declared a personal interest in any item on the Poppy Appeal, as he is a Volunteer.

Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.12.16 regarding highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Marsden declared an interest in item 06.12.16, as he works in the Aviation Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee; Cllr Marsden also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work.

03.12.16- To confirm the minutes of the meetings held on 1st November 2016

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Page and seconded by Cllr Bridges.

05.12.16 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items are covered on the agenda.

06.12.16 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

Cllr Marsden was unable to attend the November ACC meeting, but Cllr Wells attended. Cllr Wells complained to the ACC regarding low flying

aircraft over the village. He also questioned why the low flying aircraft signs did not mention the further information as previously requested. The Airport Representative is looking into this.

Noise Monitoring - The latest figures available for September are all within Government guidelines.

07.12.16 (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

A public meeting was held on 29th November in Kirmington to discuss ideas for a Neighbourhood Watch scheme. There was a presentation by North Lincolnshire Council and PC Lee Fuller. A local resident - Wendy Kinnell has volunteered to co-ordinate the Neighbourhood Watch scheme. The Parish Council expressed their thanks to her.

Wendy is going to research an informal approach and look into whether funding is available from North Lincolnshire Council for signage. Clerk advised Wendy any information can be emailed to her to be displayed on the Parish Council website.

It was resolved - To include an item on Neighbourhood Watch update on agendas in future for updates.

Wildlife Crime - Cllr Marsden reminded residents to report any incidents of lamping, badger baiting and hare coursing.

08.12.16 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Hannigan advised a second Executive Director has been appointed at North Lincolnshire Council in the new year - Simon Green.

Cllr Hannigan advised the Kirmington paths will be slurry sealed before Christmas.

Cllr Hannigan advised North Lincolnshire Council will again offer grants to Parish Councils towards their precepts for the new financial year.

Cllr Gallimore asked Cllr Hannigan when the C137 in Croxton will be re-surfaced. He will look into. He will also enquire as to when the verge near

Croxton church will be tended to.

Cllr Page advised of deep pot holes near to Melton Ross bridge - Cllr Hannigan informed he has already reported this to North Lincolnshire Council.

Cllr Page advised of pot holes in Brocklesby Park - he is going to report them direct to Lincolnshire Council.

West Lindsey have not replaced the deer signage - Clerk to chase.

Cllr Marsden advised Lincs Aviation Heritage think they should be preserved. After much discussion, **it was resolved** - to remove the item from the agenda, as the general feeling was the majority of Councillors present did not feel it is a Parish Council issue.

The Parish Council have been awarded £12,000, the top award for the Memorial Garden project. Cllr Page asked the Chairperson if some of this award can be spent at the Church. He could not reply, as Cllr D'Souza has all of the information and was not present at the meeting.

Cllr Marsden suggested a working group should be formed with 3 members from the Parish Council & 3 others. Cllr Green will speak to Peter Lancaster to ask for him to be involved or possibly Chair the group.
