

KIRMINGTON & CROXTON PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting, held on Tuesday 7th March, 2017, at Kirmington Bowls Club.

01.03.17- To note Apologies for Absence

Cllr Walton, Cllr Clark

02.03.17 - Declarations of Interest need to be remade and recorded in the minutes even if an interest has been declared in the register

Cllr Marsden declared an interest in item 06.03.17, as he works in the Aviation Industry and is a Member of the Airport Consultative Committee; Cllr Marsden also declared an interest in Bristow Helicopters as he is undertaking some consultancy work.

Cllr Marsden declared an interest on item 09.03.17 regarding highway issues on the C137 as he owns a property accessed by this road.

Cllr Wells declared an interest on any item on the agenda in connection with North Lincolnshire Council, as he is a Representative.

03.03.17- To confirm the minutes of the meetings held on 7th February 2017

These were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Wells and seconded by Cllr Green.

04.03.17 - Public Participation

None.

05.03.17 - To receive the Chairmans Report - an update on decisions taken at previous meetings

All items on the agenda.

06.03.17 - To receive an update from the Airport Consultative Committee meeting and Noise Monitoring

Cllr Marsden reviewed the November ACC meeting minutes and advised the new hotel is due to be opened in April; the arrivals hall has been refurbished; the Airport bus service is back to normal; the airplane proposal

on the roundabout is pending. Cllr Marsden is to remind Capt. Liz Forsyth, Chief Pilot of the Search & Rescue Unit, to liaise with the Parish Council regarding the low flying aircraft issue.

Noise monitoring - Cllr Marsden has reviewed the latest figures available for December 2016 and they are within Government guidelines.

07.03.17 (a) - To receive any updates from NATS and discuss any items to be raised at the next NATS meeting and any further Police Matters and any updates on Country & Wildlife Crime

The next meeting is scheduled for 13th March.

Wildlife Crime - there has been a hare coursing incident in Hibaldstow recently. The offenders were caught and had their vehicles crushed.

(b) Any update on Neighbourhood Watch Scheme

No updates.

(c) Any ideas for reviewing the Emergency Plan

This has been reviewed and accepted. Once the new Airport hotel details are known the plan will be updated.

Cllr Page advised some of the salt stored at Lancaster's Yard has burst in the bag. He will check if the salt is still available and advise the Clerk accordingly.

08.03.17 - To receive a report from Local Councillors updating the Parish Council on activities within North Lincolnshire Council and determine further action

Cllr Hannigan advised North Lincolnshire Council have set their budget and an increase of 3% has been agreed for the Social Care Precept.

He advised the paths have been slurry sealed in the village.

He reminded Councillor's of comments required for the Local Plan Consultation have to be submitted by 10.04.17. Clerk advised she has distributed this for comments to the Councillor's. Cllr Wells will try to supply specific information in relation to the villages for consideration. This will be put on the agenda for discussion at the next meeting.

09.03.17 - (a) To consider any further Highways matters within the Parish for the Clerk to take up with North Lincolnshire Council

Cllr Hannigan advised he is awaiting a response from North Lincolnshire Council regarding the yellow lines at the School. **It was resolved** Cllr Wells will contact Highways to request a single yellow line with time restrictions.

Cllr Gallimore asked if arrows will be installed on the roundabout at Barnetby Top. Cllr Wells advised there are no plans for this.

(b) - Any information received regarding Contractors for the Parish Paths Partnership

None received.

10.03.17 - To receive planning decisions made by North Lincolnshire Council and consider any planning applications received where comments have to be submitted before the next meeting

11.03.17 - Any updates from Singleton-Birch

No updates.

12.03.17 - (a) - To discuss progress on the Playing Field and work to date

Cllr Green passed to Clerk the outstanding £30 Football invoice monies to be banked.

(b) - To discuss the Playground Inspection and further action required

It was resolved that Cllr Wells will inspect the play equipment mentioned and report his findings at the next meeting.

(c) - To discuss whether a further piece of Playing Equipment is required

Clerk advised there was limited funds left in the Mondegreen funding pot. **It was resolved** Clerk to apply to Tesco for funding for another 1-2 pieces of equipment. (Also, to obtain quotes from 2/3 providers). Cllr D'Souza will supply Clerk with information on the Tesco process.

13.03.17 - To discuss any further ideas for the layout of the Parish Council

Website

Clerk advised the website is still receiving many hits each month.

Clerk advised of a grant available via Ernlca for funding towards the running costs of the website for the Clerks time. **It was resolved** the Clerk to apply. Cllr Wells declared a personal interest on this item.

Cllr Marsden asked whether a link should be available to the Kirmington Chat group on Facebook. Clerk advised people who do not have access to Facebook would not be able to view and these should be kept separate as the Parish Council do not manage this group.

14.03.17 - Any update on the Memorial Garden project

Cllr D'Souza is in the process of putting together a working group. He has received 6 names of interested parties who would offer their services to assist with the project; so far. **It was resolved** Cllr Hannigan will advertise for any interest on the Kirmington Chat page, on the Noticeboards and in the Newsletter with applications to be made to the Clerk.

Cllr Marsden has tried to contact Peter Lancaster with no success.

Clerk will distribute the Terms of Reference to the Councillors.

Cllr Marsden advised he is still working on the Book of Remembrance.

15.03.17 - Correspondence

North Lincolnshire Council Local Plan - Put on agenda for next meeting

(b) - To consider entry to the 2017 Best Kept Village Competition

It was resolved to enter again this year and pay the £40 fee.

Clerk to write to the 3 Ward Councillors to ask for them to meet with North Lincolnshire Council and North Lincolnshire Council to identify hedges that need cutting back and any further issues that need attending to.

Once this meeting has taken place to consider if a meeting is then necessary with the Brocklesby Estate.

(c) - To consider a Representative to attend the Winter Service Review on 6th June, 2017 at Normanby Hall

Cllr Wells is attending already, so will represent the Parish Council.

16.03.17- Accounts

(a) To approve the February accounts - these were confirmed as a true and accurate record. Proposed by Cllr Bridges and seconded by Cllr Gallimore.

17.03.17- Minor Items

Cllr Bridges expressed concerns of cars parking near the road by Tesco's in Brigg. Cllr Wells advised this is private land so North Lincolnshire Council cannot get involved.

Cllr D'Souza advised the dog bin cannot be moved to the location required. He has noticed that there is a lack of bins at either end of the village. **It was resolved** for him to arrange 2 new dog bins to be located at the front of the Business Park and near the Bowls Club.

Cllr Wells will inform North Lincolnshire Council the bin on the A18 layby needs replacing.

Cllr D'Souza will report the fly tipping at Habrough Lane.
